WellFully is an organization that helps adolescents facing mental health crises. Clients can even reconnect with a counselor after therapy at any time on Facebook. One evening, a former client from Hot Springs was at the point of taking her own life. She connected with WellFully on Facebook, and two counselors immediately responded. The counselors worked with a suicide prevention team that drove over an hour to connect with the client in person.


