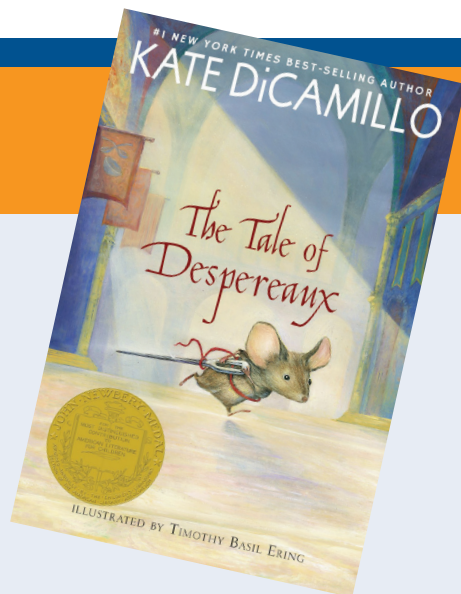

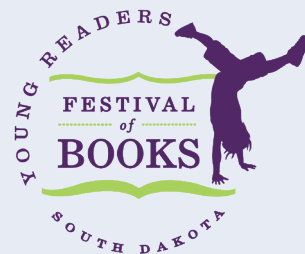
Coming in the Fall 2023
